

This analysis focuses on the student feedback regarding the syllabus and teaching methods at DAV Velankar College of Commerce. The responses have been categorized into four options: Strongly Agree, Agree, Disagree, and Strongly Disagree, with a total of 1258 responses for each question.

1. Syllabus Completion

Strongly Agree: 976 (77.6%)

Agree: 185 (14.7%)Disagree: 87 (6.9%)

Strongly Disagree: 10 (0.8%)



Analysis: A vast majority of students (92.3%) are satisfied with the completion of the syllabus, with 77.6% strongly agreeing. Only a small percentage (7.7%) have concerns about syllabus completion, indicating good management of the course schedule.

2. Content of Syllabus

Strongly Agree: 1050 (83.5%)

Agree: 125 (9.9%)Disagree: 58 (4.6%)

Strongly Disagree: 25 (2.0%)

Analysis: A significant portion of students (93.4%) found the syllabus content appropriate and satisfactory. Only 6.6% expressed dissatisfaction, suggesting that the syllabus content is mostly relevant and meets students' academic needs.

3. Critical Thinking

Strongly Agree: 1009 (80.3%)

Agree: 169 (13.4%)Disagree: 56 (4.5%)

Strongly Disagree: 24 (1.9%)

Analysis: A large percentage (93.7%) of students feel that the syllabus encourages critical thinking, with 80.3% strongly agreeing. However, a small portion (6.4%) disagree or strongly disagree, indicating that some students might feel the course doesn't sufficiently foster critical thinking.

4. Knowledge of the Subject

Strongly Agree: 1020 (81.1%)

Agree: 158 (12.6%)Disagree: 54 (4.3%)

Strongly Disagree: 26 (2.1%)

Analysis: Most students (93.7%) believe the syllabus enhances their knowledge of the subject matter, with 81.1% strongly agreeing. The small number of dissenters (6.4%) might suggest areas for improvement in teaching or content depth.

5. Usefulness

Strongly Agree: 1020 (81.1%)

Agree: 147 (11.7%)Disagree: 59 (4.7%)

Strongly Disagree: 32 (2.5%)

Analysis: The usefulness of the syllabus is generally well-received, with 92.8% of students agreeing that the content is useful. However, 7.2% disagree or strongly disagree, indicating there may be room for improvement in aligning the syllabus with practical applications.



6. Applicable in Real Life Situations

Strongly Agree: 963 (76.6%)

Agree: 205 (16.3%)Disagree: 65 (5.2%)

Strongly Disagree: 25 (2.0%)

Analysis: While 92.9% of students agree that the syllabus is applicable to real-life situations, 7.1% expressed disagreement. This suggests that a small portion of students may not fully see the connection between academic learning and its real-world applications.

7. Effective Teaching Method

Strongly Agree: 927 (73.7%)

Agree: 201 (16.0%)Disagree: 72 (5.7%)

Strongly Disagree: 58 (4.6%)

Analysis: A majority (89.7%) of students are satisfied with the teaching methods, with 73.7% strongly agreeing. However, 10.3% of students feel that the teaching methods could be more effective, indicating potential areas for improvement, particularly in student engagement and instructional delivery.

8. Assignment Projects and Assessment

Strongly Agree: 944 (75.1%)

Agree: 206 (16.4%)Disagree: 57 (4.5%)

• Strongly Disagree: 51 (4.1%)

Analysis: Most students (91.5%) agree that the assignments, projects, and assessments are well-designed, with 75.1% strongly agreeing. However, 8.5% of students disagree or strongly disagree, possibly indicating concerns about the relevance or workload associated with these tasks.

Overall Insights:

Syllabus Completion: Very well-managed, with most students satisfied.

 Content Quality: The syllabus content is largely viewed as strong, but there is still a small percentage dissatisfied.

 Encouraging Critical Thinking: The majority of students find the syllabus fosters critical thinking, though there is a minority that disagrees.

 Real-Life Application: Most students feel the syllabus is practical, but a small number see it as less applicable.

Teaching Effectiveness: A solid majority are satisfied with teaching methods, though a small
portion feels there's room for improvement.

 Assignments and Assessments: Generally positive feedback, but concerns about the relevance or workload of these assignments are present among a small group.

Recommendations:



 Addressing Critical Thinking and Practical Applications: Some students feel the syllabus doesn't sufficiently encourage critical thinking or real-life applicability. More emphasis could be placed on case studies, real-world examples, and activities that foster independent analysis.

Improving Teaching Methods: While most students are satisfied with teaching methods, it would be beneficial to explore varied pedagogical techniques (e.g., flipped classrooms,

interactive learning) to better engage all students.



1. The syllabus was completed within the planned timeframe.

• Strongly Agree: 18 (72%)

Agree: 4 (16%)Disagree: 1 (4%)

Strongly Disagree: 2 (8%)

Analysis: The majority (88%) of teachers feel that the syllabus was completed within the planned timeframe, with 72% strongly agreeing. However, 12% of teachers reported issues with the completion, suggesting some challenges in adhering to the scheduled timeline.

2. The syllabus content was relevant and aligned with current industry standards.

Agree: 3 (12%)Disagree: 2 (8%)

Strongly Disagree: 2 (8%)

Analysis: A strong majority (84%) of teachers agree that the syllabus content is relevant and aligned with industry standards. However, 16% of teachers disagree or strongly disagree, indicating a need for review and potential updates to ensure full alignment with the latest industry trends.

Analysis: While a majority (80%) of teachers find the syllabus content useful for enhancing student knowledge, 20% expressed concerns. These dissenting views may indicate areas where the content could be improved to better facilitate knowledge building or depth in the subject area.



5. The reference materials provided in the syllabus were adequate and helpful.

Analysis: The majority (80%) of teachers agree that the reference materials in the syllabus were helpful, with 76% strongly agreeing. However, 20% of teachers disagree or strongly disagree, suggesting there may be gaps in the adequacy or quality of the materials provided.

6. The syllabus helped students develop skills that are applicable in real-life contexts.

Agree: 2 (8%)Disagree: 3 (12%)

Strongly Disagree: 2 (8%)

Analysis: While 80% of teachers believe that the syllabus helps students develop real-life applicable skills, 20% of teachers expressed dissatisfaction, indicating a potential area for improvement in making the syllabus more practical and aligned with real-world contexts.

7. The teaching methods recommended for the syllabus were effective.

• Strongly Agree: 15 (60%)

Agree: 3 (12%)Disagree: 2 (8%)

• Strongly Disagree: 5 (20%)

Analysis: The responses indicate a mixed opinion on the effectiveness of the recommended teaching methods. While 72% of teachers agree, 28% disagree or strongly disagree, which highlights a significant concern about the teaching methods and the need for revisiting or improving them to enhance effectiveness.

8. The assessments and assignments were well-aligned with the syllabus objectives.

Overall Insights:

 Syllabus Completion: A majority of teachers report that the syllabus was completed on time, but some teachers faced difficulties adhering to the schedule.

Industry Relevance: Most teachers feel the syllabus content is relevant to industry standards, though a minority of them believe it may require further updates to reflect the

latest industry trends.

 Critical Thinking and Problem-Solving: While many teachers agree that the syllabus fosters critical thinking, there are still concerns about its effectiveness in fully developing these skills.

Student Knowledge Enhancement: The majority of teachers believe the syllabus is
useful for enhancing student knowledge, but some teachers feel there is room for

improvement in the depth of content.

 Reference Materials: Most teachers find the reference materials adequate, but a significant minority disagrees, suggesting that more comprehensive or diverse resources might be needed.

Real-Life Skill Development: While many teachers feel the syllabus helps students
develop practical skills, some believe there are areas where the syllabus could better align

with real-world applications.

 Teaching Methods: A notable proportion of teachers are dissatisfied with the recommended teaching methods, highlighting the need for a review and potential improvement in instructional strategies.

Assessment Alignment: Most teachers feel that assessments align with the syllabus objectives, though a sizable portion thinks the alignment needs improvement.

Workload Balance: While the majority of teachers find the workload reasonable, a
minority feel the workload might be too demanding, suggesting the need for a review of
task distribution.

Recommendations:

Update Content for Industry Relevance: Regularly review and update the syllabus to
ensure it reflects the latest trends and standards in the industry.

Enhance Critical Thinking Development: Incorporate more activities, discussions, and
case studies that foster critical thinking and problem-solving among students.

 Improve Teaching Methods: Review and diversify teaching methods to better engage students and enhance learning outcomes. Consider incorporating more interactive, student-centered approaches.

4. Better Alignment of Assessments: Ensure that assignments and assessments are more

directly aligned with the learning objectives and outcomes.

Refine Workload Management: Evaluate the syllabus workload to ensure a balance that
is manageable for both teachers and students. Consider adjusting the volume or
complexity of assignments and assessments.




By addressing these areas, the teaching experience can be further enhanced, and the syllabus can better meet both educational goals and industry demands.

Conclusion



- 8. Professionalism and Work Ethics: Graduates are viewed as exhibiting professionalism and work ethics, with a solid agreement from 9 employers.
- Overall Satisfaction: The majority of employers (9) express satisfaction with the preparedness of graduates for their industry roles, though some feedback indicates areas for improvement.

Actions Taken by the College

 problem-solving, communication, and teamwork, will be organized to further prepare graduates
 for their professional roles.
- Feedback Mechanism: A formal feedback mechanism will be established to maintain ongoing dialogue with employers, allowing for continuous improvement based on their insights and experiences with graduates.
- Professionalism Training: The college will incorporate training sessions focused on work ethics
 and professionalism, ensuring that graduates are well-prepared for the expectations of the
 workplace.

Conclusion

The employer feedback reflects a generally positive perception of graduates from DAV Velankar College of Commerce, with particular strengths in skills alignment and technical preparedness. However, there are areas identified for improvement, particularly in enhancing graduates' understanding of industry-relevant knowledge and communication skills.
